Request for information 2022-148

I refer to your request for information dated 6 September 2022, which was received by Greater Wellington Regional Council (Greater Wellington) on 6 September 2022. You have requested the following:

“Over the last 6 months, for each bus route, how many services have been scheduled. Out of these, how many have run and how many have been cancelled.

On a daily basis over the last 6 months, what % of your drivers have been off work sick?

All information over the last 6 months relating to your attempts to resolve the current driver shortage.

In addition, I'd like your comment on why trips need to be cancelled on short notice and you cannot update your system to reflect this and re-dispatch busses”

Greater Wellington's response follows:

Your request relates to information over the last six months. The period we have used to respond to this request, is the six-month period 1 March to 31 August 2022.

Scheduled bus services and cancellations

Please see *Attachment 1* which presents the number of scheduled services and cancelled services for each bus route over the six months period.

This information shows the Route number in Column A, the number of scheduled services over the six-month period in Column B, the number of cancelled services in Column C, and finally the percentage of cancellations in Column D (C/B=D). For example, 8.2% of the total services operated on the Route 2 in the six-month period detailed were cancelled.

Percentage of drivers off due to sickness

The percentage of drivers that have been off work sick over the six-month period is not information held by Metlink/Greater Wellington. This information is likely held by the operators who are the employers of the drivers. Accordingly, this part of your request is refused under section 17(g) of the Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act 1987 (the Act) as the information requested is not held by Greater Wellington or any other authority subject to the Act.

Metlink attempts to resolve the current driver shortage

The following is a high-level summary of Metlink's attempts to resolve the current shortage given the scope of your request is very wide ranging and could require substantial collation.

Metlink has placed significant effort in improving driver workforce matters over a period longer than the last six months. This has included Metlink:

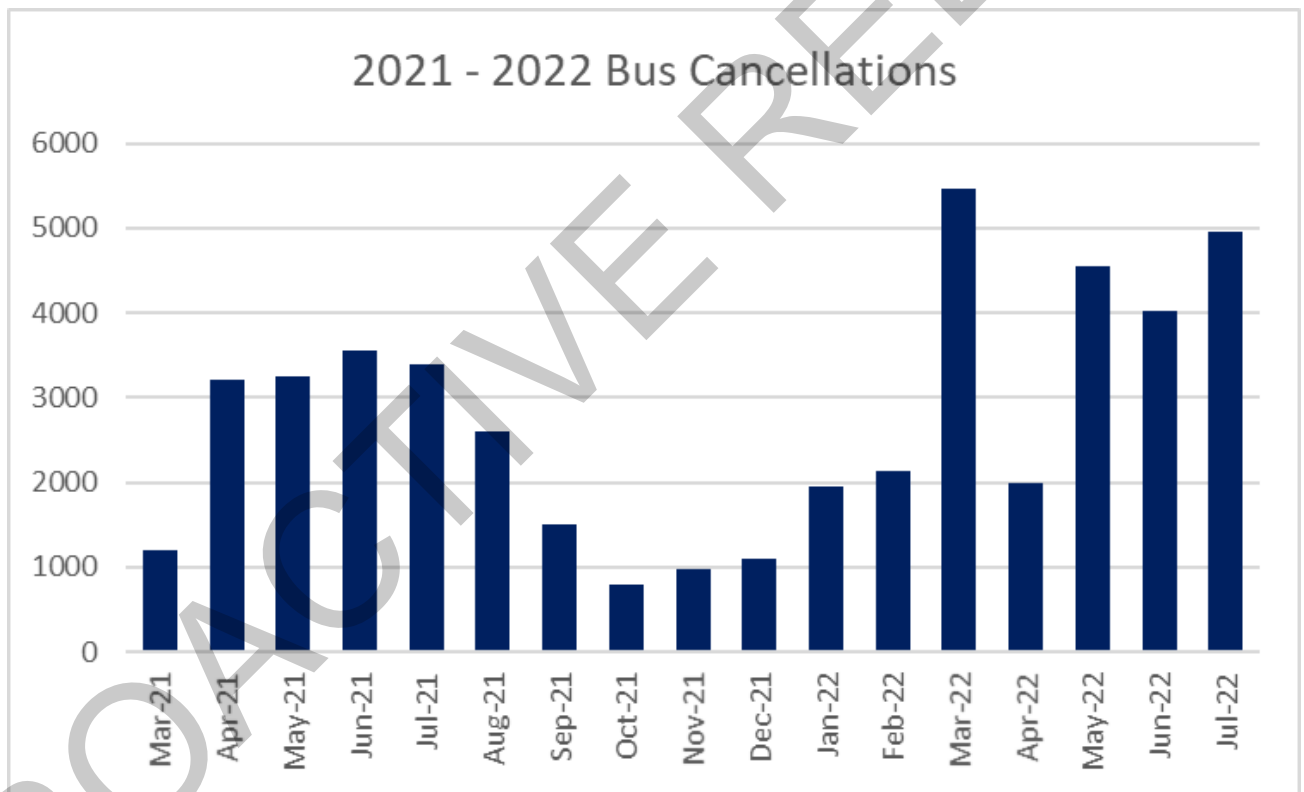
- a Funding increases to bus driver wages; All operators have accepted Metlink funding in principle and since December 2021 most have increased bus driver wages to \$27 an hour. We are still working through the final agreement with one operator before they too increase bus driver wages to \$27 per hour. This is part of our commitment to retain and attract drivers across the region.
- b Working with operators to create new and improved shifts and subsequent timetable adjustments; We introduced new timetables for both main operators in Wellington City which reduced peak driver requirements by around 10%. These changes went live for Tranzurban on 25 July 2021, and 8 September 2021 for NZ Bus.
- c Working with operators and driver unions to upgrade and add toilet facilities; This initiative is ongoing. The construction of the first toilets will start around November 2022. In the interim existing toilets have been refreshed and where needed, temporary toilets provided. When this first tranche of toilets has been constructed, we will work with Drivers, Operators and Unions to prioritise the remaining locations that require a toilet facility for our Drivers.
- d Rolling out free sanitary and incontinence products for operator staff at key locations across the network. The trial was run from October 2021 – January 2022. In March 2022 it was agreed that items would be permanently supplied to bus and rail staff.

Workforce matters remain a multi-faceted issue that Metlink continues to work on.

Trips cancelled at short notice and updates to the system

Metlink and our operators endeavour to ensure that our customers are updated on service cancellations and disruptions in a timely manner. There are occasions when this is challenging or may not happen for a number of reasons, as explained below.

Metlink’s systems are based on the relevant team entering information into our internal systems to update the Real Time Information displays. If this is not done, or not done in a timely manner our systems will not reflect the updated information on our services. We are operating in an environment with a national labour shortage of bus drivers. This has been compounded with seasonal sickness, and at different times COVID-19 peaks, impacting on bus driver availability. The graph presented here shows bus cancellations from March 2021 to July 2022.



The peaks of cancellations presented by this graph correlate with alert level changes, traffic light settings changes and COVID-19 peaks.

Bus driver availability issues can come at short notice which challenges our teams to update our systems in a timely manner. If a trip is not cancelled in our systems for reasons including a late call from a driver, or the sheer volume of work, it will appear to our customers that the trip is still operating when it is not. We also rely on the respective operator to advise us when there is a

cancellation or delay. If we are not advised of this in a timely manner, this may also contribute to an increased delay before the system is updated.

If you have any concerns with the decision(s) referred to in this letter, you have the right to request an investigation and review by the Ombudsman under section 27(3) of the Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act 1987.

Please note that it is our policy to proactively release our responses to official information requests where possible. Our response to your request will be published shortly on Greater Wellington's website with your personal information removed.
